

CAR SURVIVAL KIT

This survival kit should be kept in your car just in case you cannot access your main emergency survival kit.

Also, remember that it is a good idea to keep your automobile gasoline tank at least $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ full at all times.

- Flashlights
- First Aid Kit
- Shovel and tow chain
- Adjustable wrench
- Backpack containing jeans, sturdy shoes, a rough coat and/or rain gear
- Jumper cables
- 2 to 3 days supply of non-perishable food
- One gallon of water
- Manual can opener
- Hand knife or multipurpose pocket knife
- Matches in water-proof container
- Maps of the areas most traveled
- Spare tire

- Traction mats or chains
